Thank you for choosing the Towers leisure club (herein referred to as the club) for your membership.
With your comfort and safety in mind, we would ask you to take note of the following conditions.

Membership

Persons wishing to become members of the Club shall complete an official application form and submit it to the staff at the leisure Club. Unless expressly stated in the Club application form the member acknowledges that he/she is in good health and is not suffering from any condition or illness that may limit their ability to exercise safely.

The Management of the Club reserve the right to require any member, guest or other person to leave the premises at any time.

Membership is non transferrable from person to person. Members should note that this provision includes the non transfer of membership from one person to another within the same family.

The management may withdraw use of all or part of the facilities of the club for the purpose of undertaking maintenance work or any other works considered necessary.
Compensation of any kind will not be given for any such closure.

All members must produce their membership identification on each occasion they wish to gain access to the club facilities. Failure to produce valid membership identification may result in access to the club facilities being denied.

The management has the right to restrict the numbers using the Club at any one time.

The management reserves the right to utilise the Club facilities for special events, classes or other activities as it may deem desirable.

By joining the club, members automatically accept and agree to be bound by these conditions of membership.

Membership may be renewed on payment of the prevailing fee and in accordance with the terms and conditions then in force.

All members should note that the club's facilities are used extensively by the hotel guest.

The staff and management of the club and the hotel are not responsible for any loss or theft of or damage to any personnel property in the Club. Mini safety lockers are available for the storage of immediate valuables such as mobile phones, wallets, watches etc. Contact staff for more details.

The management of the club reserves the right to terminate any membership that is deemed by same to be detrimental to the club itself or other users of the club.

From time to time it may be necessary to alter, change or make additions to the conditions of membership.

Absolute discretion is granted to the management and staff of the Club to reject or accept any application for membership or renewal for same.

By supplying your name and address you are giving us permission to send information through the post system.

Security Cameras

Please note that security cameras are placed in and around the leisure club and including the gym area. These cameras are recording on a continuous basis.

Lost Property

It is the club policy to retain lost property for a period of 3 months only.
After this time any items that have not been collected will be disposed of.

Animals & Pets

Animals and pets are not permitted in the Club or on its facilities at any time.

Freezing of Memberships

To be eligible to freeze your membership you must be joined as a member on a membership package of 3 months or more.
You can freeze your membership for a minimum of 2 weeks only.

Your membership can not be frozen for longer than 12 months. After 12 months has expired it will automatically become active again.

You must complete a form in order to have your membership frozen

Safety & Hygiene

Members shall not use the facilities of the Club under the influence of alcohol, anti-coagulant, anti-histamines, vasoconstrictor, narcotics or tranquillisers or un-prescribed drugs or medication.

Members with diabetes, heart-problems, high/low blood pressure, on strong medical prescriptions, pregnant or who have any form of medical condition should consult their doctor before using any of the club's facilities,

in order for them to be satisfied beforehand that it is safe for them to do so. Members must also furnish a letter of clearance from their GP.

Members are particularly advised not to undertake strenuous physical activity for which they may be medically unfit and the owner will not be in any way responsible for any harm which may come to a member as a result of any such physical activity. Members are advised to have a medical check-up before embarking

on an exercise program or any strenuous activity.

Members are advised to allow at least one hour after partaking of a meal before using the club's facilities.

No food or drinks, glass or crockery are to be brought into any part of the club and only food and drink purchased in the club may be consumed on the premises.

Smoking is prohibited throughout the Club area.

Diving, running, or jumping is not permitted in the pool at any time.

Flotation devices are not permitted in the pool with the exception of armbands, floats or seated baby rings (Subject to terms & conditions).

All members must follow the instruction of the club staff at all times.

Failure to do so will result in you being asked to leave the club.

All memberships, visit vouchers are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Children in a family membership must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Pre swim hygiene is a policy of our clubs so new would ask you to please shower prior to using any of the wet facilities.

The use of mobile phones is not permitted anywhere in the leisure centre area.

For your comfort and safety the management and staff may on occasions reserve the right of admission and may limit the period of time and number of persons using the club facilities in the event of overcrowding and to insure the highest standards of safety for all users at all times.

The instruction of the leisure clubs staff must be adhered to.

Failure to do so may lead to you being asked to vacate the club.

Children under the age of 3 who will be using the pool area are obliged to wear specialised swim pants.

The use of photographic equipment of any kind – cameras, video recorders, mobile phones is not permitted in the club area.

Correct foot wear and gym attire must be worn while using equipment in the gym.

Fitness Suite/ Gym

For safety reasons this area must be kept dry. Therefore, users of these facilities are forbidden from entering the gym while wearing wet clothes.

Correct footwear such as training shoes must be worn at all times in this area.

Correct and appropriate clothing must be worn in this area at all times.

It is the responsibility of each member to wipe down each machine after use.

The booking of a fitness assessment is available by prior arrangement and 24 hours' prior notice of cancellation must be given for same. This service may lead to additional charge.

Under 16's are not permitted in the gym area at any time.

You will be required to complete a full screening for prior to any activity in the gym.

Any persons suffering from any allergies, conditions or illnesses must notify a staff member before any activity in the gym.

All persons using the gym must comply with all instructions from staff members.

Failure to do so will result in you being asked to leave the gym.

Members and guests are not permitted to use personal trainers, fitness coaches, gym coaches etc. who are not employed directly by the leisure club. Exceptions to this policy will be made by management of the club only.

The management may withdraw use of all or part of the facilities of the club for the purpose of undertaking maintenance work or any other works considered necessary. Compensation of any kind will not be given for such closure.

The management reserves the right to restrict the numbers using the club at any one time.

The management of the club reserves the right to utilise the club facilities for special events, classes or any other activities it may deem desirable.

From time to time it may be necessary to alter existing policies or add new policies as required.
